



Progress

Progress scores show how much progress pupils have made between the end of Y2 and the end of Y6. An average score is calculated so the progress of Y6 pupils in our school can be compared with that of other Y6 pupils across the country.

A score of 0 means that pupils at our school have made about the same amount of progress as other pupils nationally with the same starting point. A positive score means pupils have done better than pupils nationally with the same starting point.

Attainment

The percentage of pupils in school achieving the **expected** standard in reading, writing and maths combined was 48% compared to the national standard of 65%.

The percentage of pupils in school achieving the **higher** standard in reading, writing and maths combined was 8% compared to the national standard of 11%.
