The children will be encouraged to join in re-telling the stories 'Little Red Riding Hood' and 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt'.

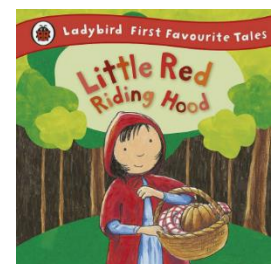
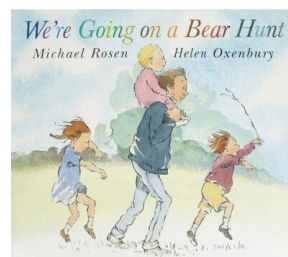
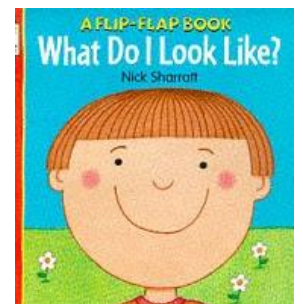
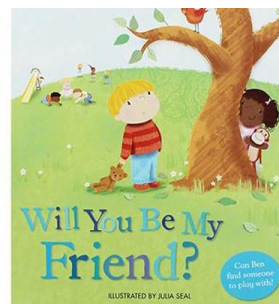
### Songs to sing at home.
